### **Page 3, Part III, Statement of Program Service Accomplishments**

#### **Program:**

Global Visionaries worked directly with 113 high school students in our year long Leadership Program in the United States and 60 students in volunteer service in Guatemala. In the U.S., 68 students are from Seattle and 20 are from San Francisco and Colorado. We worked with 25 additional Youth Board students in Seattle who learned advanced leadership and facilitation skills to be able to co-lead all aspects of our first year program. We led three cultural immersion and service work trips with the 88 U.S. participants to Guatemala. During trips, student lived in home stays, studied Spanish, participated in ecological and archeological excursions, and most importantly, served on four international work teams. As mentioned earlier, 60 Guatemalan high school students collaborated with our U.S. students in this volunteer work including school building, reforestation, and work in a hospital and coffee cooperatives.

During trips, each student gained over 100 hours of Spanish immersion. Students planted over 2,000 trees and volunteered well over 500 hours at San Pedro Hospital in Antigua, Guatemala. Global Visionaries participants helped finance and build two classrooms in *Segunda Cruz (Pastores)* and one classroom in *Cerro del Nino (Pastores)*, Guatemala.

Students also served our local Seattle community in five different Work Teams in collaboration with local organizations including EarthCorps, Global Partnerships and Seattle Parks and Recreation. Each student served a total of 70 hours. They worked in 6 Seattle parks eliminating invasive species, restoring natural habitats, and constructing safe trails. Global Visionaries participants in the Microlending Work Team met with over 125 students from four elementary and middle schools, educating the younger students about global poverty and micro-finance as a solution to poverty. Students organized 2 major supply drives, collecting and donating 120 large boxes of medical, school, office and construction supplies to Guatemalans in need. We initiated our first “Carbon Emissions Reduction Day” by involving our students and the community in planting trees locally to offset the carbons emissions produced by our flights to Guatemala.

Student engaged in a variety of grassroots fundraising activities to raise money for their service projects in Guatemala. Our Water-Walk-A-Thon brought students together for a 4-mile walk highlighting the plight of water scarcity issues worldwide. The event helped raise money for a microloan to a small business in Guatemala. For the first time, Global Visionaries students sold GV Café: organic, shade-grown coffee produced by a farmer cooperative in Guatemala and roasted, packaged, and exported by Espresso de Esperanza (Espresso of Hope), a group of young entrepreneurs from the same community. While in Guatemala, a group of Global Visionaries participants worked directly with the farmers and members of Esperanza de Esperanza to learn about the process of making coffee and the international coffee trade.

**Page 3, Part III, Statement of Program Service Accomplishments**

For the first time, our social justice curriculum, a 6-hour workshop on systematic oppression, was facilitated by members of the Youth Board. Six students trained for 6 months to successfully lead three workshops, using Theater of the Oppressed structures and de-briefs to guide their peers in challenging discussions about racism, classism, sexism, and other forms of oppression.

**Development:**

We had our 6<sup>th</sup> annual auction which raised \$80,000 and were successful with other fundraising efforts including stock and car donations. Our major donors program was very successful. We began our first “year end mail appeal” which made \$2,000. The Seattle Repertoire Theatre and Topics Entertainment continued their support and sponsorship of Global Visionaries. We received grants from The Lisle Foundation, TeamTrio, and Starbucks.
